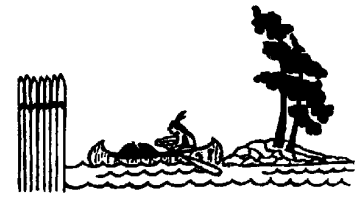

The selected work will be on display December 6th, 2003 to January 3rd, 2004. All artists are invited to the opening reception on December 6th at 1:00 p.m.

2nd Place \$500

3rd Place \$200

Honourable Mentions: \$50 each

Entry Fee: \$10 per piece, maximum 2 pieces per artist

Eligibility

*Artists must be 18 years of age or older and residents of Simcoe County (permanent or seasonal). Proof of age MUST be provided if requested.

*Entries must be entirely the work of the entrant.

*Entries must be original; entries must not be copies, derivatives or based in any way on other copyrighted or published paintings or photographs.

Conditions

*All works must be framed and ready for display. Two-dimensional works must be ready to hang with proper hardware and wiring installed. Explanatory diagrams or photographs must accompany works requiring special installation.

* By entering the exhibition the artist grants the Museum the right to photograph works for publicity, educational and reference purposes.

*No entry may be withdrawn once it has been accepted.

Sales

*The Museum will collect 20% commission on all sales.

Entry

*A non-refundable, **cash** payment of \$10 per piece is required, to a maximum of two pieces per artist. A dyptych or tryptych is classified as one piece.

*Works will be accepted into the Museum on Friday, Nov. 28th and Saturday, Nov.29th from 9a.m.-5 p.m., NO EXCEPTIONS. The Museum does not have space to store work prior to these dates.

*Size of work is limited to no more than 4 feet in any direction.

Accepted/Declined Works

*Works will be juried and artists will be notified of the status after Dec. 1st. Work not accepted into the show must be picked up prior to December 7th. The Museum will not be responsible for work left in the Museum after this date.

Liability

Every reasonable precaution will be taken during the receiving, installation, exhibition and return of work, however Huronia Museum assumes no responsibility for loss or damage incurred. Work should not be so fragile that public display is potentially harmful to the work or the viewer.
