Race Course: New 13.3-mile rolling course with 350 feet of climbing per lap located in the same general area of the old course used in previous years. Start/Finish located on Anza Rd. just north of De Portola Rd. heading north to Rancho California Rd. turn right to Glen Oaks Rd. turn right to De Portola Rd. turn right back to Anza Rd. Please do not warm-up on the course or congregate at the start/finish line area. You can warm-up on Anza Rd. south of the parking area or bring trainers. Feed zone area is located past the start/finish line area in the designated area.

Directions: From the I-15 Freeway, exit on Highway 79 exit Indio and head east to Anza Rd. Turn left then proceed to parking and registration area. Please park on the shoulder of the road and do not block any driveways or entrances to private property. Please do not leave any trash on the side of the road and use the provided toilet facilities. Race Course: 1.3-mile circuit course used before during the district championships in the mid 90's with one short sprinter's hill. Start & Finish line located on Business Park Dr. near Rancho Way. Three turns heading clockwise starting on Business Park Dr. right turn on Single Oak Dr., right turn on Business Park Dr. down hill sweeping turn back to finish line.

Directions: From the 15 Freeway exit on Rancho California and head west to Diaz Rd. turn right to Rancho way turn left then proceed to parking and registration.

Registration & Information:

- Pre-Registration postmarked by June 2, 2003. Post entries will pay an additional \$5.00, unattached riders pay additional \$5.00. All entries include \$2.00 USCF insurance surcharge.
- Post registration and race numbers pick-up will be available Friday night June 6, 2003 at the Pechanga Casino Hotel.
- All 2003 USCF rules apply. Centerline rule strictly enforced.
- Neutral support follow vehicle will be provided for 1-2 Pro field only in the road race. Riders provide your own wheels. Other categories can volunteer follow vehicles for support. No personal support vehicles will be allowed on the road course.
- Neutral pit area will be available for the criterium. Riders provide your own wheels.
- The promoter reserves the right to adjust the prize list per the number of entries registered for that particular event. Race rain or shine. No refunds.
