Welcome to that most English of island capitals, Hamilton! Bermuda—a self-governing part of the British Commonwealth—is often classified as “Caribbean”, but it’s an Atlantic archipelago situated further north than the Caribbean Sea. The balmy Gulf Stream weather delighted English settlers back in the 1600s, and will have the same effect on you. Relax, slow down, and enjoy: the offshore water is crystal-clear, the coral sands are pink, and the speed limit is 20 mph...Points of interest abound: the 36-acre Bermuda Botanical Gardens, welcoming visitors since the 1890s with over 1000 species of flowers, herbs, and trees; the exquisitely preserved 18th century Verdmont Mansion Museum with its collections of antique porcelain, furniture, and art; beautiful South Shore Beach; Hamilton’s historic City Hall; the Underwater Exploration Institute; and many, many more.



June 22, 2003 **St. George’s, Bermuda**

Your final day in Bermuda takes you to the “olde towne” of St. George’s, where the settlement of the colony began in the early 17th century. There are many opportunities to sightsee and absorb authentic Colonial British flavor in the town’s cobbled streets and winding byways, which lead to pubs, galleries, shops, libraries and gardens. 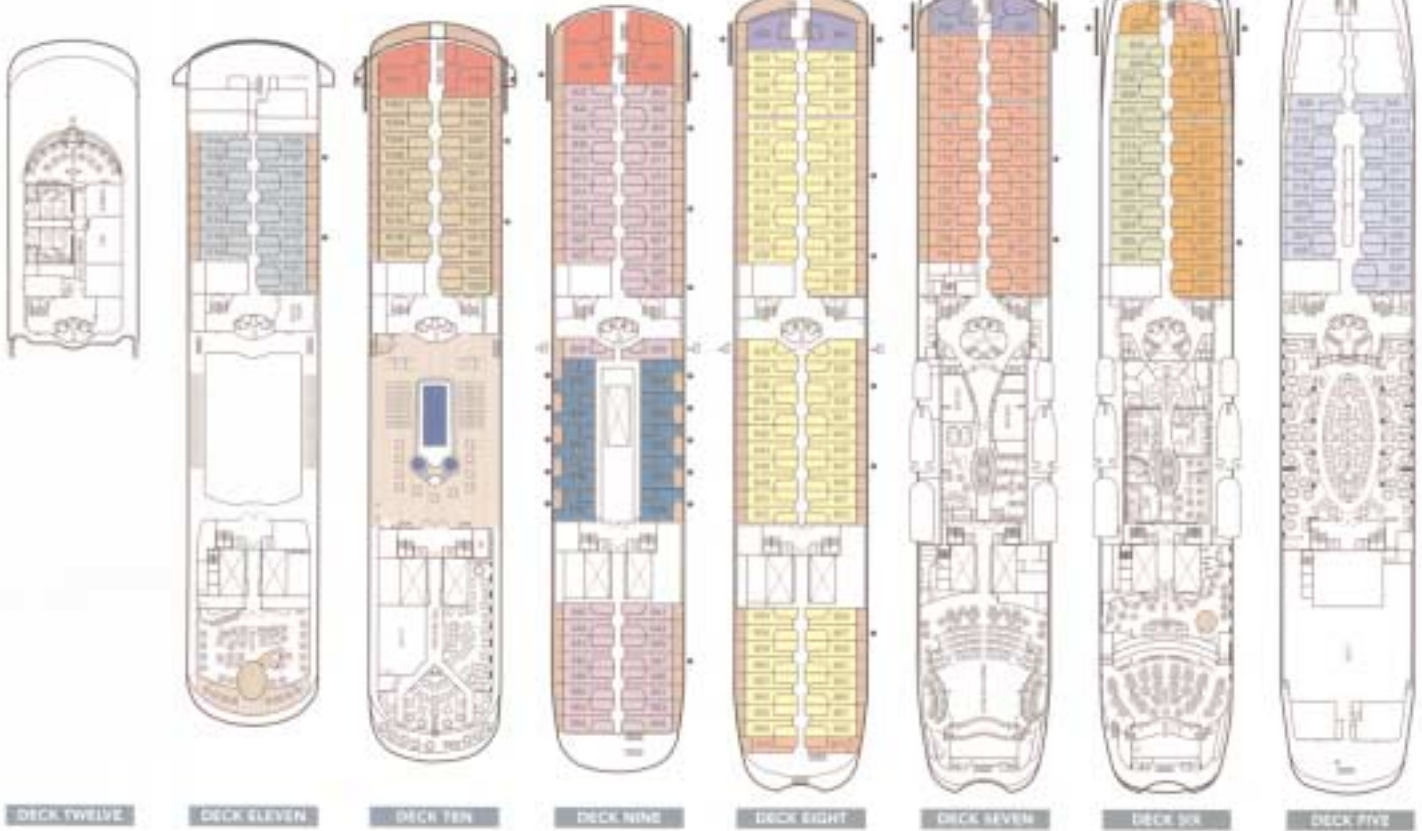
